## Forms of Skin Cancer - The first in an educational series

**Basal cell carcinoma** is also known as BCC. Basal cell carcinoma is the most common type of cancer in humans. Luckily, it is very rarely a threat to life. BCC typically affects adults of fair complexion who have had a lot of sun exposure, or repeated episodes of sunburn. Although more common in the elderly, our sun-loving society are developing them in their early 40s and sometimes younger. The tendency to develop BCC may be inherited and can vary in size from a few millimeters to several centimeters in diameter. They usually grow slowly over months or years. Your first line of defense is limiting exposure and wearing sunscreen with a sun protection factor of 30 every day.
